

Agreement on '2+2 Undergraduate Dual Degree Program' between Inha University and International University named after K.Sh.Toktomamatov

Inha University (henceforth abbreviated as INHA) and International University named after K.Sh.Toktomamatov (henceforth abbreviated as INU) hereby agree to sign an Agreement on '2+2 Undergraduate Dual Degree Program' based on the Memorandum of Understanding between the two Universities.

1. Purpose of the Program

The purpose of the program is to develop higher education and strengthen the cultural exchange between the two countries by jointly cultivating the talents with internationalization capabilities and creativity.

2. Contents of the Program and Conditional Pre-admission

A. English Track Program

- (1) The students participating in this program are to enter the undergraduate course of INU, complete a two-year (or more) curriculum of either Business-related departments or IT-related departments, and transfer to INHA as third-year students of one of the following departments : International Business and Trade (IBT) Department in School of Global Convergence Studies (SGCS), Integrated System Engineering (ISE) Department in School of Global Convergence Studies (SGCS), GLOBA in School of Business Administration, and Hospitality in School of Business Administration. Then students will obtain bachelor's degree from INHA and INU simultaneously on the condition that they meet the undergraduate graduation requirements required by INHA and INU.
- (2) Students participating in the program must pass admission screening and language proficiency qualifications (IELTS, TOEFL iBT) required by INHA.
- (3) The admission requirement for English language proficiency of students at INU, who will participate in this program and transfer to INHA, is IELTS 5.5 or TOEFL iBT 71 or higher for Department of IBT, ISE, GLOBA, and Hospitality, all of which teach in English.

B. Korean Track Program

- (1) The students participating in this program are to enter the undergraduate course of INU, complete a two-year (or more) curriculum and transfer to INHA as third-year students. The students can choose the compatible majors at INHA except Medicine, Nursing, Education, Architecture, and Arts & Sports, according to the laws of the

Republic of Korea and regulations of INHA. Then students will obtain bachelor's degree from INHA and INU simultaneously on the condition that they meet the undergraduate graduation requirements of both INHA and INU.

- (2). Students participating in the program must pass admission screening and language proficiency qualifications (TOPIK) required by INHA.
- (3) The admission requirement of Korean language proficiency for the students at INU, who will participate in this program and transfer to INHA, is TOPIK Level 4 or higher.

C. Conditional Pre-admission

In addition to the general admission process, INHA may conduct conditional pre-admission based on document screening and interviews for those recommended by INU, and issue certificates only for those who pass the conditional pre-admission screening process.

Those who pass the conditional pre-admission screening process can be admitted to INHA upon submitting IELTS 5.5 or TOEFL iBT 71 or higher for English track programs, and TOPIK level 4 or higher for Korean track programs within the set deadline (within one and a half year from the date of the issue of the certificate for conditional pre-admission). If certificates for the language proficiency are not obtained within a set period of time, the qualifications for the conditional pre-admission will automatically be revoked. And through the conditional pre-admission screening process, INHA can provide admission scholarships to the outstanding students of INU. Details of the conditional pre-admission shall be determined through consultation between the two universities.

3. Recruitment Target and Quota

- A. The recruitment target is the students within admission quota who have completed a designated curriculum for two years in the undergraduate of INU.
- B. The number of the program participants from INU shall be determined each year through mutual consultation.

4. Responsibilities and Obligations

A. Responsibilities and Obligations of INHA

- (1) INHA regularly holds info-session for students of INU and notifies them in advance of the requirements and documents necessary for the admission.

- (2) INHA shall support the procedures required for the program participants' entry into Korea.
- (3) INHA shall apply the school and academic regulations equivalent to all international students to the program participants.
- (4) INHA shall confer bachelor's degrees to the participants, if they meet the graduation requirements of INHA.
- (5) INHA shall cooperate when the program participants with its bachelor's degree, desire to continue their postgraduate studies at the graduate school of INHA.

B. Responsibilities and Obligations of INU

- (1) To ensure the successful performance of this program, INU shall recommend outstanding students and endeavor to promote activities related to recruiting students.
- (2) INU shall provide INHA with all documents, such as certificate of enrollment, certificate of completion, and transcript of the students participating in this program.
- (3) INU confers bachelor's degree to the program participants who meet the graduation requirements of INU.

5. Tuition

- A. While a student participating in the program is studying at INU, tuition fees shall be collected by INU, in accordance with its own standard, and shall be collected by INHA, in accordance with its own standard when studying at INHA. In addition, all other expenses, such as dormitory fees and living expenses, which are required to study at INHA, shall be paid by the program participants.
- B. The tuition fee per semester to be paid by the students participating in the program while studying at INHA is as follows; Engineering(including ISE) is 3,600,000 KRW, Natural Science is 3,400,000 KRW, Humanities/Social Science(including IBT, GLOBA, and Hospitality) is 2,800,000 KRW.
The Tuition fee is set based on the current INHA tuition fee (fall semester, 2020), and is subject to change in conjunction with INHA tuition.

6. Modification, Expiration, and Termination of the Agreement

- A. This agreement is to be executed in two sets of identical copies in English by authorized representatives of each party, and INHA and INU shall retain one set of

- the agreement. The agreement shall take effect from the date it is signed.
- B. The term of validity of this Agreement shall be five years, and each party shall notify one another in writing six months prior to modification or termination of the Agreement. If neither party raises issues on amendment or termination of the Agreement, it shall automatically be deemed to have been extended for five years.
 - C. After the Agreement has been signed, it guarantees mutual compliance with the terms of the Agreement for those who are already participating in the Program.
 - D. Matters not mentioned in this Agreement and problems arising in the course of the program shall be resolved in consultation on the basis of the spirit of friendly cooperation between the two parties
