MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between

KAZIMIERAS SIMONAVIČIUS UNIVERSITY

and

UNIVERSITY OF ECONOMICS AND ENTERPRISE

1. INTENTION

The objective of this Memorandum of Understanding is to develop an extensive educational, advanced academic research and a cultural partnership between the Kazimieras Simonavičius University and the University of Economics and Enterprise, based on equality, reciprocity, mutual academic and educational benefits to the faculty and staff of both institutions. Both universities, represented with their acronyms KSU and UEE can be viewed and referred in this document in the single mode as "Party" and collectively as the "Parties". The Kazimieras Simonavičius University (Kazimiero Simonavičiaus universitetas - hereinafter KSU) and the University of Economics and Enterprise (Экономика жана ишкердик университети - hereinafter UEE), city of Jalal-Abad, Kyrgyz Republic, are committed to strengthen bilateral cooperation at a university level education, research and development in humanities, social sciences and engineering.

2. AREAS OF ACTIVITY

KSU and UEE aspire to implement a high level of cooperation which may include and not limited to the following:

- a) Lead and establish contacts for mutual cooperation and research between the Faculties of KSU and UEE which are involved in similar academic programs and curriculum development, in order to improve teaching methodology, technological innovation, research and development as well as adopt cutting edge practices.
- b) Organize joint scientific research activities based on a common goal towards allocating the European Union funding sources towards education and scientific projects led by KSU and UEE.



c) KSU and UEE will join efforts to work together with the The Organisation for Economic Co-operation and adequate supportive firms and all other relevant organisation within the field of joint interest.

d) Organize and participate in conferences, seminars, symposiums, short-term study programs and bilateral academic meetings of mutual interest aimed to improve teaching and scientific research in medical, engineering and social sciences.

e) Exchange information on academic research and scientific publications. Provide mutual assistance to publish scientific articles in quarterly academic journals, published in Kyrgyz Republic and Lithuania and improve curriculum standards.

3. CONTRACTUAL ACTIVITIES

Before conducting any kind of activities, both Parties will consider the relevant issues on the satisfaction of each party and engage into certain activities on the basis of common interest, agreement that are established clearly on the outcomes of each project and activity that is planned. The activities envisioned by this Memorandum of Understanding will contain specific conditions as stated below:

a) Establishment of a bilateral commission with members from KSU and UEE that will coordinate and plan the activities organized by both universities.

b) Consideration of each responsibility in each institution towards implementing forthcoming projects and mutually beneficial actions.

c) Special drafting of projects and plans for mutual activities.

d) Individual decisions to be taken on the budget and sources for funding a variety of events.

e) Detailed management of intellectual property rights and publications by faculty and staff of both parties.

f) Consider any other items necessary for the effective management of bilateral events.

4. COORDINATORS

The coordinators will be appointed by each institution to serve as mediators for the implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding. All activities carried out under the auspices of the Memorandum of Understanding must be approved by the coordinator of the KSU and UEE.

On behalf of the KSU, the coordinator is: Mrs. Vaiva Poškaitė-Tomaševič, (International Relations Coordinator), and on behalf of the UEE, the coordinator is: Mrs. Torogeldieva Aktalina Begimkulovna (The head of the international relations department of UEE, Candidate of Economic Sciences, Associate Professor). Coordinators will inform one another if there is a need to appoint a new person with the same responsibilities and in the same position.

5. RENEWAL, TERMINATION AND AMENDMENT

5.1 . This Memorandum of Understanding shall remain in force for a period of five years from the date of signing of this Memorandum. This Memorandum of Understanding may be extended with the written consent of the parties.

5.2 . This Memorandum of Understanding may be terminated by either party by sending a written notice to the other party at least 180 days before the deadline of item 5.1. Any termination and / or cancellation of this Memorandum shall not affect the activities that are in progress, on the basis of specific activity agreement and will continue to be the same until the end of fulfilling the obligations of the parties in accordance with their conditions or in some other way agreed between the parties in writing.

5.3 . This Memorandum of Understanding may be amended only by written agreement of the parties.
