



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between
International University named after K.S.H. Toktomamatov
Kyrgyzstan, Jalal Abad

and

Zhejiang International Studies University
Hangzhou, China

PURPOSE OF THE AGREEMENT

International University named after K.S.H. Toktomamatov and Zhejiang International Studies University (ZISU) recognize the benefits to be gained by both institutions through cooperative interactions that strengthen academic entities of both institutions.

I.SCOPE

International University named after K.S.H. Toktomamatov and Zhejiang International Studies University realize that partnerships that facilitate international educational exchange and the participation in joint academic and educational ventures provide opportunities to enhance each institution and promote cross-cultural understanding. Programs and activities associated with this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) shall be consistent with the missions of the respective institutions. International University named after K.S.H. Toktomamatov and Zhejiang International Studies University hereby agree to explore opportunities for collaboration to their mutual benefit. Nothing in this MOU is intended to affect, alter or amend either institution's legal rights or obligations with respect to the other institution.

II.PROPOSED DEVELOPMENTS

IU named after K.S.H. Toktomamatov and ZISU intend to develop collaborations on a variety of joint academic and educational activities that shall include, but will not be limited to:

- a) Exchange of information and academic materials;
- b) Visits by and exchange of research, training and other staff;
- c) Visits by and exchange of students and faculty;
- d) Coordination to deliver instruction for designated degree programs;
- e) Development of collaborative research and other projects; and

- f) Organization of joint academic activities such as lectures, seminars, conferences, symposia, short training courses and modules of interest to both Universities.

A timetable for processing developments will be agreed upon by the two institutions. Supplementary agreements may be established governing specific programs and activities developed under the auspices of this agreement. The proposed developments will be subject to the relevant quality assurance arrangements between International University named after K.SH. Toktomamatov and ZISU.

III. FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

It is understood that funding will be required to undertake specific activities and could be provided by the Universities or external sources.


IV. DURATION OF THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This MOU is initially valid for five years from the date of the signature by the Rector professor IU named after K.SH. Toktomamatov Omurzakov Satybaldy and Professor Hong Gang, president of Zhejiang International Studies University. Either party may terminate this MOU upon six months' notice, so as to give any current programs sufficient time to conclude. The notice provision shall not negatively affect any programs at the time of the decision. At the end of the five-year period, it will be considered for renewal. This MOU will be automatically renewed in case none of the parties will inform the other party about its decision to terminate it before the expiration of the validity period.

INTERNATIONAL ACADEMIC EXCHANGE AGREEMENT

Between

International University named after K.SH. Toktomamatov

Kyrgyzstan, Jalal Abad

and

Zhejiang International Studies University

Hangzhou, China

International University named after K.SH. Toktomamatov and **Zhejiang International Studies University (ZISU)** hereby agree to exchange students according to the following arrangement. Other specifics as needed will be further developed, outlined and agreed accordingly.

- 1) International University named after K.SH. Toktomamatov and ZISU agree to exchange 4 (four) students on a semester-for-semester basis, undergraduate student for undergraduate student. While it is desired to maintain a balanced exchange between universities, each university may determine for itself the degree of balance; an even exchange balance is not required. The preferred length of study will be one semester and will not exceed twelve months.
- 2) Students will be selected by their home university using appropriate academics, language and other necessary criteria. The staff and/or faculty of the home institution will screen applicants for the exchange program with respect to each student's maturity, academic and linguistic ability.
- 3) Each student selected for participation in this exchange program will be admitted as an exchange (non-degree) student to the host university upon submission of all application materials. Final acceptance shall be subject to review and agree by the host institution.
- 4) With the approval of the host institution students shall be permitted to enroll in any courses for which they are academically and linguistically qualified with the exception of those courses or programs in which space is limited due to enrollment requirements.
- 5) Students do not need to pay tuition fees to the host institution but will be personally responsible for other fees, including but not limiting to accommodation, airfare, registration, textbook rental, health insurance, any special course fees and all personal expenses while being abroad.
- 6) Student will still be liable to pay full-time undergraduate tuition and any other required fees established by the home university.

- 7) For the duration of studies the host university will reserve and provide to the student a room in university's dormitory for which the students will pay the full appropriate fee.
- 8) Credits earned at the host university will be officially transcribed at the host institution, and then transferred to the home institution.
- 9) Provided that there are internship programs fit for the exchange students, the host university should recommend to the exchange students and assist them in the application process. If additional information and specific arrangements are required, this clause can be elaborated or supplemented by mutual agreement of both parties.

The provision of this agreement may be amended, supplemented, or revoked by mutual agreement, in writing and signed by the authorized representatives of each party.

This agreement is initially valid for five years from the date of the signature. Either party may terminate this agreement upon six months' written notice, so as to give any current programs sufficient time to conclude. The notice provision shall not negatively affect any programs at the time of the decision.

This agreement will be automatically renewed for another five years in case none of the parties will inform the other party about its decision to terminate it before the expiration of the validity period.
